


Celina's "Rollertown" roots were seeded when the community recognized that times were








Entertainment District Local Analysis - Utilities









Entertainment District Local Analysis - Connectivity













Entertainment District Concept Diagram











Entertainment District Road Hierarchy












Two Lane Road with Parallel Parking on Both Sides*




